G.N.A.S. Rules of Shooting, including Dress Regulations, will apply.

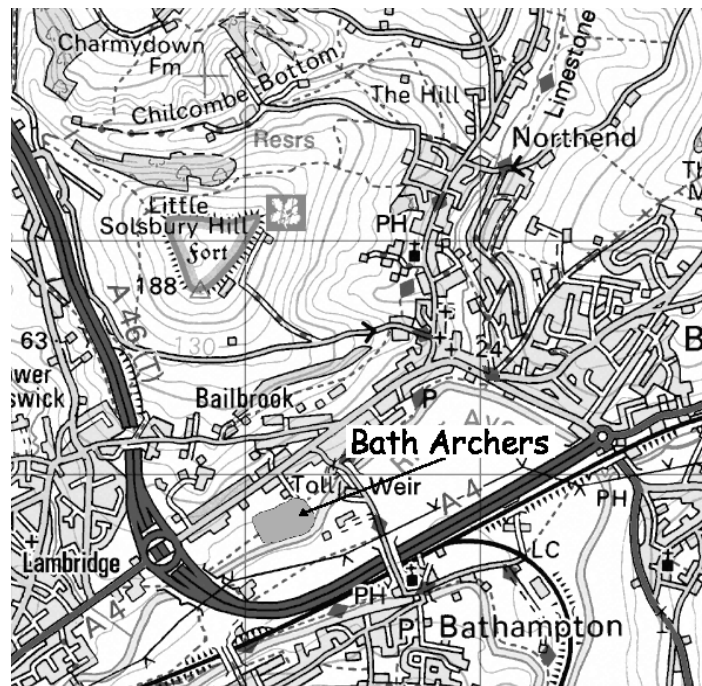
All competitors must be affiliated to G.N.A.S. and have their cards available for checking.
