- ROUNDS :** Ladies and gentlemen's FITAs with World Record Status.
- SHOOTING :** There will be three archers per boss shooting in a single detail.  
Ends of 6 arrows to be shot in 4 minutes at 90/70m and 70/60m.  
Ends of 3 arrows to be shot in 2 minutes at 50m & 30m
- PRACTICE :** From 9.00am for 45 minutes, in timed ends of 4 minutes.  
Equipment inspection from 8.45 a.m.

**TOURNAMENT WILL BEGIN AT 10.00am**

- ENTRIES :** Open to members of GNAS and FITA. Junior archers may enter and will be eligible for all awards but must shoot the appropriate senior round.  
FITA equipment regulations will apply. Entries to be made on the official form and will be treated strictly in order of receipt.
- ENTRY FEE :** £13.00 - cheques to be made payable to "Somerset County Archery Association" and sent with the completed entry form to the Tournament Organiser by 30th. August 2009 please.  
No late entries or substitutions. Target space is limited so early entry is advised.  
Please enclose 2 large (9"x 7") self-sealing stamped self-addressed envelopes for target list and results sheets or provide email address on entry form.
- DRUG TESTING :** Record Status shoots will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply - a refusal will be treated as a positive result.  
Parent / guardian must sign entries from junior archers.

#### BATTLE OF BRITAIN FITA STAR

##### Directions:-

From the M5 junction 21 (Weston-super-Mare), take the A370 signposted towards Bristol. Follow this road for approximately 5 miles going straight through two sets of traffic lights at Congresbury. Then look out for a Texaco garage on the right, and take the next turning on the right onto Wrington Road. Follow this for approximately 2 miles down into the centre of the village, past the garage and bear left into Silver Street. Follow along this road for approximately 1/3rd mile and the Recreation Ground will be on the left.

Using the A38.

From the South – Travel through traffic lights at Churchill, continue for 2.1 miles north, passing Esso garage and ignoring all turnings to Wrington. Pass the open common ground and turn left into Havyatt Road (signed 'Wrington – including trading estates'). Continue for 1.1 miles along this road into the village and the Recreation Ground will be on the right.

From the North - From the roundabout at the entrance to Bristol Airport, travel south on the A38 for 3.9 miles, turn right into Havyatt Road (signed 'Wrington – including trading estates'). Continue for 1.1 miles along this road into the village and the Recreation Ground will be on the right.
